CHAMBERFEST

The Piccolo is half-size flute and a member of the woodwind family of musical instruments. Sometimes referred to as a "baby flute". The modern piccolo has similar fingerings as the flute but the sound it produces is an octave higher. Enjoy listening to it at the concert!



Georges Bizet (1838-1875)



Georges Bizet was born in Paris, France. Both his parents were musicians, and they actually wanted their son to become a composer when he grew up! Bizet loved music, but he also loved to read books. His parents wound up hiding his books so that he would spend more time on his music.

When Georges was 10 years old, he went to the Paris Conservatory and graduated from the Conservatory with awards in both composition and piano.

Bizet composed operas. His most famous opera is Carmen. You will hear an excerpt from Carmen at the concert.
