- Unnecessary use of electronic devices (i.e. cell phones, iphones, blackberries, ipods, etc.), while on duty:
- Consumption of alcohol or intoxication;
- Possession or use of drugs and/or illegal substances;
- Harassment, in any form;
- Destruction of OCMS property or harm to any venue used by the festival;
- Inappropriate requests toward artists;
- Insubordination;
- Breach of confidentiality;
- Theft;
- Failure to perform assigned tasks;
- Any other serious breach of the Code of Conduct.
